

## **Economic Impact Study**

- 1240 licensed insurance entities, \$473b total aggregate assets and \$123.6b premiums written (2008 numbers)
- 40% of US property & catastrophe insurance provided by Bermuda class 4 insurers
- 25% of US medical malpractice cover
- 25% cover to US reinsurance market
- 27% cover to EU reinsurance market
- More than 250,000 US Farms in 40 states depended on Bermuda insurance products to hedge crop related risks

- 4 licensed banks with over \$22.3b total aggregate assets
- Growing international shipping registration with 159 commercial vessel on the registry
- Growing international aircraft registration with over 500 aircraft on the registry
- BSX, nearly 700 listed entities with a total market capitalisation of approx. \$355b

- The value of assets: \$ in excess of \$22 billion.
- The return on assets exceeds the 8% minimum rate required by the Basil Agreement on Capital Requirements



### Bermuda Monetary Authority



#### Purpose

- 1. To issue and redeem notes and coins
- 2. To supervise, regulate and inspect any financial institution which operates in and from within Bermuda
- 3. To promote the financial stability and soundness of financial institutions
- 4. To supervise, regulate or approve the issue of financial instruments by financial institutions or by residents
- 5. To assist with the detection and prevention of financial crime
- 6. To foster close relations between financial institutions themselves and between the financial institutions and the Government
- 7. To manage exchange control and regulate transactions in foreign currency or gold on behalf of the Government
- 8. To advise and assist the Government and public bodies on banking and other financial and monetary matters
- 9. To perform such functions as may be necessary to fulfill the said objects

- Bermuda Stock Exchange has numerous recognitions and designations, including:
  - S.E.C, F.S.A., Australia, Ireland, UK Customs, and many others
- Provides services 24 hours through an electronic platform
- Rated Number 1 Offshore Exchange in the world and in the top 15 worldwide
- Largest Offshore Exchange
- Secondary Exchange for companies in the process of incorporating or to get onto other exchanges such as the NASDAQ

  - Highly skilled lawyers, actuaries, accountants, finance, and risk professionals






